We, at Grayling Township, have tried to make recycling as easy as possible for you with our car-trunk to market service by those working at the recycling facility. All you have to do is prepare your recyclables at home according to the general rules below, throw them in the trunk of your car and drive to the recycling center. It generally takes less than one minute, and you're on your way.

Get Into Recycling..... with these few simple rules

Yes.....Clear glass jars – please rinse. remove and discard plastic caps

Yes.....Newspapers and inserts

Yes.....Magazines, Books, Catalogs, Phone Books – Bundle with newspapers

Yes.....Cardboard - Boxes, containers, brown paper bags (remove all packing material)
Please flatten bulky cardboard items

Yes.....#1 Plastic bottles – must be clear plastic, rinse jugs and discard caps.

Yes.....#2 Plastic bottles and jugs - various colors, rinse jugs and discard caps.
No hazardous substance containers, no auto oil containers

Yes.....Plastic milk jugs and opaque plastic bottles - rinse jugs and discard caps

Yes.....Tin cans – rinse

Yes.....Aluminum cans and aluminum foil products – rinse

Yes.....Styrofoam – Egg cartons, meat trays, popcorn packing material

Yes.....Batteries – from auto to AAA

Yes.....Brush and trees – cut and trim to convenient handling size. Trunk must not exceed 6" in diameter. No roots, stumps or building materials.

Yes.....Leaves and grass clippings – try to separate, as much as possible, leaves and pine needles

NO.....Non-recyclable items – garbage, food scraps. Non-recyclable items may be discarded at our on-site trash compactor. You must have a 2010 trash compactor sticker (you should have received it with your winter tax bill in December) in order to dispose of non-recyclable trash.
